## VETERINARY CLINIC



NGAP's in-house veterinarians are specialists in greyhound health and see over 3000 greyhounds annually...more than any other facility in the country.

A growing number of our patients are non-greyhound canines and felines.

## BOARDING

We board over 600 dogs annually. Our guest dogs enjoy a clean comfortable climate-controlled kennel and spacious walk-in cages with soothing background music. Dogs are fed twice a day and exercised five times a day in either an interior or large 20 x 100 fenced-in canopied outdoor space.

All dogs boarded at NGAP must be current on both Rabies and Kennel Cough vaccinations.

A live-in caretaker is on the premises. Both our indoor and outdoor spaces are monitored using a 24- hour surveillance system.

For the past 20 years, our kennel has been a temporary home to 40-60 greyhounds. Our kennel staff is constantly busy taking care of the dogs from 6am to 10pm seven days a week.

To help the staff and the dogs, we initiated our dog-walking program to help socialize the dogs and give them some added quality time.

365 days a year, weather permitting, we allow dog lovers to come and walk our wonderful greyhounds. Anyone is welcome to stop by during our visitor's hours. We have a nice campus-like area where the dogs love to stroll.
