WHAT WE DO:

The National Greyhound Adoption Program is a nonprofit organization, home-based in Philadelphia, PA. Since its conception in 1990, over 7,000 ex-racing greyhounds have been rescued and adopted out to caring homes. Greyhounds are rescued from racetracks, medical testing, experimentation facilities, or abandoned at local area shelters. Racing establishments alone are responsible for the death of thousands of young greyhounds each year, just because they can't run fast enough. NGAP will respond anywhere in the United States if there is one greyhound in peril. NGAP also has excellent medical facilities to deal with any problems the adopted hounds might have throughout the rest of their lives. NGAP also is very aggressive in shadowing racing activities and initiates action against abuse and inhumane treatment. NGAP remains one of the strongest advocates against dog racing in the country.

All of this is possible because of many dedicated volunteers and donations from people who care to save these intelligent, gentle and affectionate dogs.
